The 2023 Pemberley Sculpture in the Vines runs from 21st to 30th of April, open daily from 11am - 4pm. Pemberley of Pemberton is located at 104 Ockwell Road, Eastbrook 6260.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Pemberley Sculpture in the Vines is open to Western Australian artists.
2. A fee of \$30 per single entry or \$55 for two entries. Financial Pemberton Arts Group (PAG) members fee \$25 per single entry or \$45 for two entries. Entry fees are non-refundable.
3. Maximum 2 sculptures per artist.
4. Artists must complete and return the Entry Form by Saturday 1st of April 2023.
5. Image of work should be emailed to pembertonart2023@outlook.com at the time of submitting entry form.
6. Selection Panel at its absolute discretion reserves the right not to accept an artwork where it is determined as inappropriate for the intent or location of the exhibition. The Panel's decision is final.
7. Judging will take place at the exhibition location. Awards will be presented at the official opening at Pemberley, Saturday 22nd April, which contributing artists are asked to attend. Invitations will be sent closer to the official opening date.
8. The decision of the judges will be final and binding upon every person who enters the competition. No correspondence will be entered into.
9. All sculptures eligible for awards must not have been exhibited in Pemberley Sculpture in the Vines previously.
10. All artwork must be labelled with the artist's name, contact phone number, title of work, medium and selling price.
11. No artwork may be removed during the exhibition.
12. All works must be for sale.
13. A commission of 20% for PAG members or 25% for non-members will apply on all sales and must be included in the sale price. Shire contribution does not attract commission.
14. Where a work is sold, PAG will collect payment and inform the artist of the purchase.
15. PAG is not responsible for the removal, freight or delivery of sold sculptures.
16. Artists are responsible for the transport of artworks to the exhibition and all associated costs, plus the transport of any unsold works from the exhibition, unless using the depot service.

17. The installation of 3D work is the responsibility of the artist. WorkSafe practices must be adhered to. Artists to supply own plinths and ensure stability of their installation. Sculptures from depot service will be installed by on-site staff unless instructed otherwise by the artist.
18. Artists are responsible for their own insurance.
19. PAG will contact artists if their artworks have been sold. In this case, collection arrangements are to be made by the artists directly with the purchaser. PAG will provide the artist with the purchaser's contact details.
20. 3D artworks must be suitable for outdoor installation and dimensions must be provided on the Entry Form.
21. Artists' works may be photographed and reproduced for publicity.

DEPOT SERVICE:

Delivery to depot: 12pm – 4pm Friday 14th – Sunday 16th April, 2023.

Unit 2, J Shed, 1 Fleet St, Fremantle – The Greg James Sculpture Studio.

Please respect that J Shed is a working studio. Sculptures must be delivered and collected on specified days and times.

IMPORTANT:

- Sculptures must be crated and secured, wrapped if necessary (truck is an open backed tray top)
- Sculptures heavier than 30kg need to be secured to a base (such as a pallet) to be forklifted onto truck
- Crates and packaging clearly labelled
- Height & width limits for transport: Truck can accommodate crated and secured sculptures not exceeding these dimensions: Height 3m x Width 2m x Length 3.9m

STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC ART:

Only sculptures which meet Public Art Standards as below will be considered for acquisitive awards that result in public display.

- No sharp edges or other characteristics which could cause injury;
- No finger traps or other entrapments;
- Sculptures to be robust, well-constructed and stable;
- Sculptures must be enduring in construction and materials
